Beginning September 1, 2016, at least one medication you take won't be covered on your drug list.

Express Scripts will manage your prescription plan for UHA Health Insurance beginning June 1, 2016. We help make safe and effective medications available for you.

A national panel of physicians and pharmacists continually reviews and compares medications to make sure your drug list is comprehensive. However, some medications may no longer be included when there are similar safe and effective alternatives.

Beginning September 1, 2016, certain medications will no longer be covered on your drug list. This means you will pay the full retail price if you refill a prescription for one of these medications after September 1.

Your doctor can prescribe another effective medication that's included on your drug list. **Please visit <https://uhahealth.com/express-scripts> for a list of excluded medications and their covered alternatives.**
