UHA Health Insurance has good news! We have selected Express Scripts as our new Pharmacy Benefits Management (PBM) Company for your pharmacy benefit needs and drug prescriptions.

What Does This Mean?

- UHA will have a new formulary that will mean coverage for some medications and supplies will change starting **June 1, 2016**.
- If you are using one of the following diabetes devices, these will no longer be covered on our plan:
 1. Accu-Check test strips
 2. Contour test strips
 3. Freestyle test strips
 4. Truetest/Truetrack test strips

To help with this change, we have enclosed a new meter for your use. We hope this will allow you to continue checking your blood sugar levels without interruption.

Your new UHA member ID card (for your medical and pharmacy benefits) will be sent to you in the mail. Please use your new ID card beginning **June 1, 2016**. Contact information for Express Scripts will also be provided on the ID card.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but hope that your new glucose monitoring device will encourage you to continue daily monitoring of your blood sugar levels.
